



Emergency First Aid for schools 1 day

Course Overview

Our Emergency First Aid for Schools course is designed for employers to fulfil the legal responsibilities of the Health and Safety (First Aid) Regulations 1981. All organisations must ensure by law that they have a sufficient number of employees that possess a first aid qualification in order to fulfil their first aid needs at all times.

The Emergency First Aid for Schools course is designed to enable participants to attain the knowledge and skills needed to deal with a range of emergency first aid situations. At the end of the course participants will be able to demonstrate the practical administration of safe, prompt and effective first aid in emergency situations with an understanding of the role of the first aider.

Who is this course for?

This course is designed for people who have a specific responsibility at work, in school, or in voluntary and community activities, to provide First Aid when dealing with an emergency situation. There are no formal entry requirements but in order to benefit from the course participants should possess reasonable communication skills.

Dealing safely and effectively in an emergency situation,
Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation
CPR Practice for adults & children
Treatment of an unconscious casualty inc. seioures
First aid equipment

Recognising and treating Shock,
Choking,
Minor injuries,
Wounds and bleeding - treatment
Recording incidents

Duration: 1 day.

Certification: After the course successful participants will receive an Emergency First Aid at Work certificate, valid for a period of 3 years, after which the learner will need to retake the course in order to remain qualified. If you, wish to upgrade to Level 2 Award (QCF), you will be required to take a multiple choice question paper. £12.00 extra per certificate.
